WHITE RIVER RESPONSE TO CRISIS IN THE HORN OF AFRICA

You may have seen news reports on the Crisis in Somalia and Kenya. We have prayed for God to intervene in this desperate situation. Here are 2 ways you can help:

*Volunteer to pack meals with "Kids Against Hunger." The meals are specifically formulated to meet the nutritional needs of a starving child. You can help pack food at the Red Cross at 15325 Herriman Blvd on September 17. Shift times: 9-11AM & 12-2PM. Donation to provide food is \$20/youth, \$30/adult, or \$50/family per shift. *Help provide a long term solution to drought in the village of Isinon - a remote Kenyan village experiencing severe drought. The only source of water is a tiny stream with barely a trickle of water that is not fit for human consumption. The women walk to the stream, carrying their 5 gallon containers in hope of water - most of the time, there is none - then they do it again, day after day after day - always hoping. Over the past two years, teams from WRCC have teams brought relief to severe infestations from a jigger infestation that left many of them unable to walk. Later, dozens of goats were purchased enabling people to provide for themselves. Now to protect these people from recurring droughts, a deep well called a "Borehole" is needed. This will provide an ongoing source of safe, clean water for the village of Isinon. We may not be able to help all of the people in the Horn of Africa in this time of crisis but we can make a difference for these friends of ours in Isinon. With just \$15,000 we will continue our partnership with the village in bringing life giving water. Will you help?
