**Who Should Apply:** Adults and Youth 5th grade or older.

**Trip Dates:** Saturday, March 31—Saturday, April 7, 2012 (Spring Break)

- Depart from WRCC on Saturday morning at 8am and return the following Saturday evening.
- Transportation: rentals and/or personal vehicles.

**Trip Cost:** \$500 per person

- Trip cost includes lodging and meals during our time in New Orleans.
- **Payment Schedule:** \$100 with application; \$200 by 3/4/12; and \$200 by 3/18/12.

- Return entire application with \$100.00 deposit to reserve your spot.
