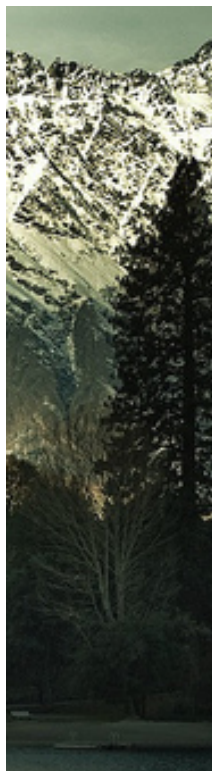

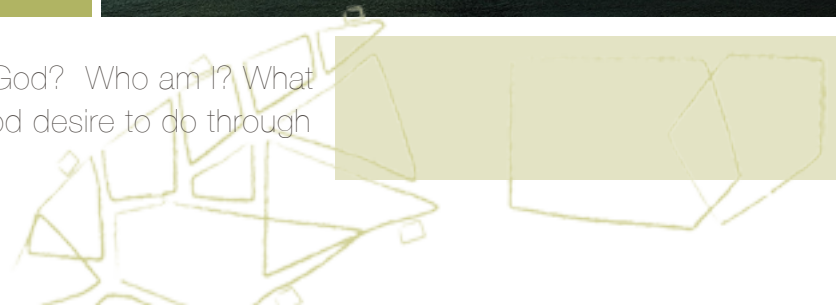

WHAT TO EXPECT:

You will participate in this process with a group of 8 to 10 people, led by a trained facilitator who will encourage safe relationships, thoughtful reflection and honest conversation.

Your group will select a time of the week that works for everyone and meet for two hours each week for 26 weeks, beginning in early September and concluding in early May. (December is an off-month.)

You will spend two to four hours each week reading and prayerfully reflecting on the biblical content presented in the manuals, the recommended reading and practicing new spiritual disciplines. You will be asked to commit to regular attendance, faithfully do the homework and fully participate in the conversation.

You will meet monthly with a mentor or spiritual friend for conversation and support.
