

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Once you have experienced The Emerging Journey to explore the questions: Who is God? Who am I? and What does God desire to do through me?, an important question to consider is "What is the next step for my development as a leader?" Through the Equipping Experience, you will add to the development of practical skills to do the work and activity of leadership.

The cost is \$300 for 26 weeks, which includes 4 workbooks and 5 textbooks. A \$60 registration fee is required and a payment plan is available. Couples can share some materials reducing the cost to \$540 per couple. While we realize the cost is significant, the result is as well! You will be investing in your continued walk and relationship with Christ.

Through a commitment of weekly meetings, mentoring relationships, leadership lessons, and ministry projects, you and your group members will continue the lifelong developmental journey to lead *like Jesus*.

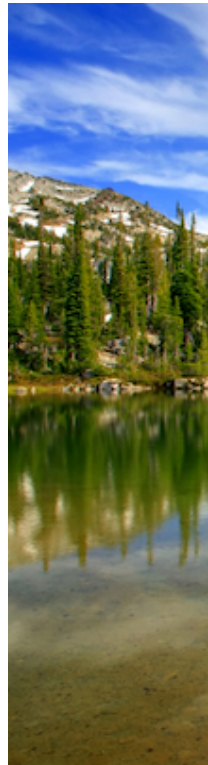

WHAT TO EXPECT:

You will participate in this process with a group of 8 to 10 people, led by a trained facilitator who will encourage safe relationships, thoughtful reflection and honest conversation.

Your group will meet for two hours each week for 26 weeks, beginning in early September and concluding in early May. (December is an off-month.)

You will spend two to four hours each week reading and prayerfully reflecting on the biblical content presented in the manuals, the recommended reading and practicing new spiritual disciplines. You will be asked to commit to regular attendance, faithfully do the homework and fully participate in the conversation.

You will meet monthly with a mentor or spiritual friend for conversation and support.
