FINANCIAL BOOT CAMP

First Monday of Every Month, February-December 2009

This is a 12-month intensive course taken by individuals in the church, overseen and taught by volunteers with financial and legal expertise. The class will meet once per month, the first Monday evening of each month, beginning February 2, 2009. Individuals will be expected to meet with one of the teachers, independently of class time, approximately 4-6 times during the duration of the course for creation and implementation of a customized financial plan (based on their personal circumstances) and ongoing review and measurement of progress. Journaling throughout the duration of the course will be encouraged. Topics to be covered will include Biblical stewardship, budgeting, debt pay-off, giving, saving/investing, identity theft protection, credit monitoring, estate planning, risk management (insurance), & dispute resolution.
