AMERICAN HERITAGE GIRLS OUTREACH

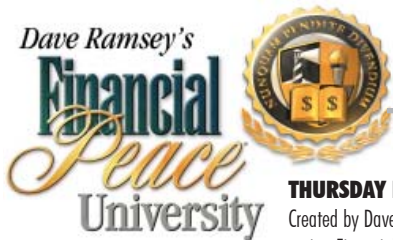

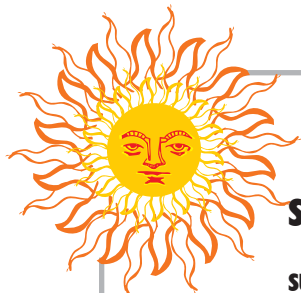
