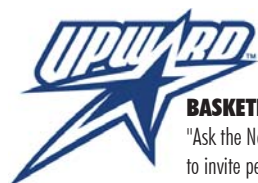
### BAPTISM CELEBRATION November 23 | 5:30-6:30pm | Worship Center
